#### 4.1. ADOPTION OF 2019/20 BUDGET

#### **MOTION:**

- 1. That Council re-draft and revise the 2019-2020 budget to give effect to a zero percent rate increase for the 2019-20 financial year.
- 2. That the savings required of \$2.535 million be achieved by removing the proposed renovation of the Town Hall Ballroom (\$1.0 million) and by requesting the CEO to remove \$635,000 from across the 70 different business units and service areas of Council.

The remaining \$900,000 can be found by providing the \$1.9 million needed for the Library Redevelopment in two stages, with \$1 million provided this year, rather than \$1.9 million and the remaining \$900,000 delivered in the 2020-21 budget.

3. That following the re-drafting of the budget, Council authorises that public notice be given in accordance with sections 129 and 223 of the Local Government Act 1989 of its intention to adopt the proposed revised budget and set the rates and charges for 2019-20 year at a future Special meeting.

#### **RESOLUTION:**

#### Council resolves:

- 1. It has considered all submissions and presentations made to Council at its Special Meeting held on 19 June, 2019.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 130 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, to accept the Draft 2019/20 Budget and Strategic Resource Plan 2019/20 to 2022/23.
  - 2.1 Discloses that as at 30 June 2019 the total amount borrowed by Council is \$39.627 million
  - 2.2 Proposes that the total amount proposed to be borrowed during the financial year other than borrowings to refinance loans is \$10 million.
  - 2.3 Projects that \$3.910 million will be redeemed during the financial year;
  - 2.4 Projects that as at 30 June 2020 Council borrowings will total \$45.717 million.
  - 2.5 Projects that the cost of servicing the borrowings during the financial year will be \$2 million.
  - 2.6 Proposes that rates in the dollar for each type of rate to be levied for the 12 month period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 are:

- 2.7 Proposes that no municipal charge be declared; and
- 2.8 Proposes that a Service Charge of \$363.10 per service be levied for the 12 month period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 on residential and other permitted properties for the collection, removal and disposal of refuse and recyclables where the service is provided.
- 2.9 Proposes that a Service Charge of \$70.30 per service be levied for the 12 month period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 for collection, removal and disposal of greenwaste on all residential properties with a detached house (including houses and granny flats and bungalows) on land sized between 250m2 and 4,000m2, where the service is provided.
  - i. Properties eligible for a greenwaste service may apply for additional service(s) subject to approval by Council's Waste Services Unit. Any additional service(s) will be charged an additional Greenwaste Service Charge.
  - ii. Properties that do not meet the criteria for a Greenwaste service may apply to opt into the service provided that the property is located on an existing collection route. Applications to opt in to such service will be subject to approval by Council's Waste Services Unit.
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of section 171 of the *Local Government Act* 1989, Council will waive \$92.50 of the Rates levied for the 2019/20 on properties were the ratepayer:
  - a) Is an eligible recipient within the meaning of the *State Concessions Act* 2004 and has qualified for a waiver under section 171(4) of the Local Government Act, and,
  - b) Who lives alone in their own home and is solely responsible for the payment of rates and charges on that property.

The objective of this waiver is to provide assistance to Pensioners who are the sole ratepayer and are recipients of the pension.

4. In accordance with the provisions of section 171 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, Council will waive the Rates levied for the 2019/20 year on properties where the property is classified as Recreational 1 for rating purposes.

The objective of this waiver is to provide financial assistance to those sporting and recreational clubs that are required to pay rates.
