PURPOSE

- Having failed to reach a decision for this matter at the Planning Delegated Committee of 13 April 2021, the matter was returned to the Committee on 11 May 2022. At the meeting of 11 May 2022 the Planning Delegated Committee resolved to defer the matter to provide an opportunity for the applicant to consider an amendment to the proposal that would consider incorporating a single story element to the proposal. The applicant, having considered the Committees request has chosen not to amend the application and this report is before the Committee to determine a position on Planning Permit Application PLP/2021/566, 17 Park Street, Wendouree.
- 2. The report has been modified to address matters raised in previous Committee meetings. These include:
 - The applicant's response to objections and comments by the Planning Delegated Committee;
