The Expo will be held at Ballarat Civic Hall at 300-304 Mair Street Ballarat, 3350.

On-street parking is available around the venue and throughout the Ballarat CBD Free parking is available within a short distance of the venue at Doveton Crescent.

Metered parking is available at the following locations:

- Ararat Street
- Market Street
- Armstrong Street North
- Doveton Street North



DROP OFF/PICK UP ZONE

There are designated accessible parking permit carparks close to the venue:

- 2 parks in the Ballarat Library carpark, enter off Doveton Street North
- 2 in Market Street, between Doveton North and Armstrong streets
- 4 in Armstrong Street, between Mair and Market streets.

There will be 3 designated 5-minute parking spaces at the front of the venue to support quick drop-off and pick-up for anyone who needs.



Civic Hall is a big building. It has three doors at the front that I can use to get inside.

Helpers will be at the doors to welcome me.



When I go through the doors I will be in the foyer.

There will be displays and information I can look at here before going into the Expo.

I might think the lights feel bright in the foyer.

I might notice a contrasting zig zag pattern on the floor.

I can stay close to my support person.




Inside the hall there will be lots of different stalls set up. I can visit the stalls to learn more about City of Ballarat services.

I can ask a Helper or support person to show me where to find the quiet space.






There will be Helpers at the Expo.
